

# DOMAINE DE LA GRAND' COUR

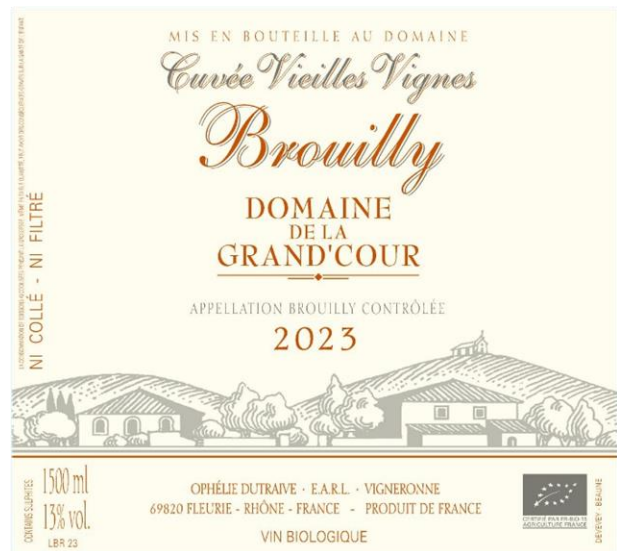

## *Cuvée* BROUILLY « Domaine de la Grand'Cour » Vieilles Vignes

This *Brouilly* *cuvée* comes from a deep clay-limestone *terroir* at the east of the *Brouilly* appellation in the village of *Charentay*, from the area (*lieu-dit*) named "*Vuril*".

With a surface of 1,7 hectares, the parcel is composed of old vines with an average age of over 60 years old. The vines are south-facing, reaching an altitude of 230 meters. 2023 saw a yield of 34hl/ha.

The grapes were vinified in concrete tanks and the wine was aged in 50% oak barrels and 50% stainless-steel tanks for 8 months.



Following the philosophy of the domain, the vines are cultivated without any chemical fertiliser or herbicides, creating wines which are above all an expression of *terroir*, showcasing the soil and the winemaker's craft.

- Hand-harvested with pierced 20kg cases
- Cold whole-bunch vatting at 7-8°C
- Carbonic maceration
- Indigenous yeasts
- No SO2 added during the vinification or ageing
- Neither fined, nor filtered
- Little (10mg/l) or no SO2 added during blending

The 11.5 hectare estate is owned and managed by the Dutraive family. Domaine de la Grand' Cour produces wines made from Gamay across two appellations: the *crus Fleurie* (9.8 hectares) and *Brouilly* (1.7 hectares). The vines are organically cultivated and certified since 2009.

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
