

DOMAINE DE LA GRAND'COUR

Cuvée FLEURIE « Domaine de la Grand'Cour » Lieu-dit Champ*gne

This *Fleurie* *cuvée* comes from vines situated on our 1,5 hectares of “*Champ*gné*” *terroir* in the south of the *Fleurie* appellation. The parcel is composed of very old vines of between 70 - 80 years old. The vines are south-east facing and sit on a shallow sandy topsoil and a bedrock of weathered granite, reaching an altitude of 260 meters. The 2023 harvest yielded 23hl/ha.

The grapes were vinified in concrete tanks and the wine was aged in oak barrels for 8 months. Following the philosophy of the domain, the vines are cultivated without any chemical fertiliser or herbicides, creating wines which are above all an expression of *terroir*, showcasing the soil and the winemaker's craft.

- ☑ No SO2 added during the vinification or ageing

- ☑ Little (10mg/l) or no SO2 added during blending

The 11.5 hectare estate is owned and managed by the Dutraive family. Domaine de la Grand' Cour produces wines made from Gamay across two appellations: the *crus Fleurie* (9.8 hectares) and *Brouilly* (1.7 hectares). The vines are organically cultivated and certified since 2009.

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
